## **Back to the Basics – The Bible**

Various passages

## Introduction

We need to occasionally be reminded about the basics, the core beliefs and disciplines that are central to a godly life. There are few things in the Christian life that could be more basic and important than the Bible.

Today we are going to see what the Bible says about itself, with a goal being that we be driven to read it, know it, and live it.

## **Biblical Background**

Psalm 119:

<sup>9</sup>How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to Thy word.

 $^{11}\mathrm{Thy}$  word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against Thee.

<sup>74</sup>May those who fear Thee see me and be glad, Because I wait for Thy word.

 $^{92}$ If Thy law had not been my delight, Then I would have perished in my affliction.  $^{93}$ I will never forget Thy precepts, For by them Thou hast revived me.

<sup>97</sup>O how I love Thy law! It is my meditation all the day.

<sup>105</sup>Thy word is a lamp to my feet, And a light to my path.

Acts 17:10-12 - <sup>10</sup>And the brethren immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea; and when they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. <sup>11</sup>Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily, [to see] whether these things were so. <sup>12</sup>Many of them therefore believed, along with a number of prominent Greek women and men.

2 Timothy 3:13-4:4 - <sup>13</sup> But evil men and impostors will proceed [from bad] to worse, deceiving and being deceived. <sup>14</sup> You, however, continue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned [them]; <sup>15</sup> and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; <sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work. <sup>1</sup> I solemnly charge [you] in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: <sup>2</sup> preach the word; be ready in season [and] out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. <sup>3</sup> For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but [wanting] to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires; <sup>4</sup> and will turn away their ears from the truth, and will turn aside to myths.

James 1:19-21 - <sup>19</sup> This you know, my beloved brethren. But let everyone be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger; <sup>20</sup> for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God. <sup>21</sup> Therefore putting aside all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls.

James 1:22-25 - <sup>22</sup> But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who

James 1:22-25 - <sup>22</sup>But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves. <sup>23</sup>For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; <sup>24</sup>for *once* he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. <sup>25</sup>But one who looks

intently at the perfect law, the <i>law</i> of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man shall be blessed in what he does.

2 Peter 1:19-2:3 - <sup>19</sup> And [so] we have the prophetic word [made] more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts. <sup>20</sup> But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is [a matter] of one's own interpretation, <sup>21</sup> for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. <sup>1</sup> But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves. <sup>2</sup> And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned; <sup>3</sup> and in [their] greed they will exploit you with false words; their judgment from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

Ephesians 6:14-17 - <sup>14</sup> Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, <sup>15</sup> and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE; <sup>16</sup> in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming missiles of the evil [one.] <sup>17</sup> And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
