## The Fear of the Lord

Ps. 34:7-16

<sup>7</sup>Th e angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them. <sup>8</sup>O taste and see that the LORD is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him! <sup>9</sup>O fear the LORD, you His saints; For to those who fear Him, there is no want. <sup>10</sup>Th e young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the LORD shall not be in want of any good thing.

<sup>11</sup>Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD. <sup>12</sup>Who is the man who desires life, And loves *length of* days that he may see good? <sup>13</sup>Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit. <sup>14</sup>Depart from evil, and do good; Seek peace, and pursue it. <sup>15</sup>Th e eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous, And His ears are *open* to their cry. <sup>16</sup>Th e face of the LORD is against evildoers, To cut off the memory of them from the earth.

Central Truth: Living in the fear of the Lord will result in God's positive involvement in your life.

Definition: The fear of the Lord is "not a mere fear of His power and righteous retribution, but a wholesome dread of displeasing Him ..." (Vine's)

Luke 12:4 And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. <sup>5</sup>But I will warn you whom to fear: fear the One who after He has killed has authority to cast into hell; yes, I tell you, fear Him! 12:4 Λέγω δὲ ὑμῖν τοῖς φίλοις μου, μὴ φοβηθῆτε ἀπὸ τῶν ἀποκτεινόντων τὸ σῶμα καὶ μετὰ ταῦτα μὴ ἐχόντων περισσότερόν τι ποιῆσαι. <sup>5</sup>ὑποδείξω δὲ ὑμῖν τίνα φοβηθῆτε· φοβήθητε τὸν μετὰ τὸ ἀποκτεῖναι ἔχοντα ἐξουσίαν ἐμβαλεῖν εἰς τὴν γέενναν. ναί λέγω ὑμῖν, τοῦτον φοβήθητε.

## Benefits:

- 1. Protection and deliverance from danger. (Ps. 34:7, Pr 14:27)
- 2. No lacking, of any good thing. (Ps. 34:9)
- 3. Life, long life, good. (Quality of life) (Ps. 34:12, Pr 10:27, Pr 14:27, Pr 19:23, Pr. 22:4)
- 4. God's constant attention to meet your needs. (Ps. 34:15)
- 5. Beginning of wisdom. (Ps 111:10, Pr 9:10) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
- 6. Confidence. (Pr. 14:26) In the fear of the LORD there is strong confidence, And his children will have refuge.
- 7. Depart from evil. (Pr. 16:6) By lovingkindness and truth iniquity is atoned for, And by the fear of the LORD one keeps away from evil.
- 8. Direction (Ps. 25:12) Who is the man who fears the LORD? He will instruct him in the way he should choose.

## Dangers:

- 1. Enmity with God. (Ps. 34:16)
- 2. Shortened life. (Pr. 10:27) The fear of the LORD prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.

How does a person fear the Lord?

- 1. Keep tongue from evil. (Ps. 34:13)
- 2. Keep lips from lying. (Ps. 34:13)
- 3. Depart from evil. (Ps. 34:14)
- 4. Do good. (Ps. 34:14)
- 5. Seek peace. (Ps. 34:14)
- 6. Obey God's Word. (Ps. 112:1) Praise the LORD! How blessed is the man
- Praise the LORD! How blessed is the man who fears the LORD, Who greatly delights in His commandments. 7. Hate evil, pride, arrogance, the evil way, perverse mouth. (Pr. 8:13)

The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way, And the perverted mouth, I hate.
